II. General Information about Data Processing

1. Scope of Processing of Personal Data

Our processing of the personal data of our users is limited to the data necessary to provide a functioning website as well as our content and services. Processing of personal data of our users only occurs for the purposes agreed upon with them or when another legal basis (in terms of the GDPR) exists. We only collect personal data that is actually required for the performance and processing of our tasks and services, or that you have voluntarily provided to us.

1. Provision of the Website

We store this information for a maximum period of 360 days. The storage is for data security reasons to ensure the stability and operational security of our system.

We analyze the usage of our website using the web analytics tool provided by <u>Wix.com</u>. This is solely for the purpose of optimizing the website in terms of user-friendliness and providing useful information about our services. There is no merging of this data with other personal data sources or disclosure to third parties.

The legal basis for the temporary storage of data and log files is Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR. No personalized evaluation takes place, and the analyses are based on anonymized data sets. Statistical evaluations are kept for 360 days.

We use "Google Analytics," a web analytics service provided by Google Inc., 1600 Amphitheatre Parkway, Mountain View, CA 94043, USA, to evaluate website usage. Google Analytics uses cookies (see section 2 below) that are stored on your computer. Information about the visitor's website and internet usage contained may be processed and analyzed by Google.

Data collected by Google may be transferred to countries outside the EU and EEA, particularly the USA. However, Google adheres to the Privacy Shield Framework. Further information about your rights under this framework can be found at http://ec.europa.eu.

Additionally, we ensure that your IP address is anonymized before being transmitted to Google.

The legal basis for using Google Analytics is Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR.

2 Cookies

We use cookies on our website to make our offer more user-friendly. Cookies are small files that your browser automatically creates and which are stored on your end device (laptop, tablet, smartphone, etc.) when you visit our site. Cookies remain stored until you delete them. This allows us to recognize your browser when you visit our site again.

If you do not wish to use cookies, you can configure your browser to inform you about the setting of cookies and allow them on a case-by-case basis. However, we would like to point out that disabling cookies may limit the functionality of our website.

The legal basis for processing data through cookies is Art. 6(1)(f) GDPR. The cookies remain valid for 360 days and are subsequently deleted by your browser.

3. Contact Form

If you fill out a contact form or send us an email or any other electronic message, your information will only be stored for the purpose of processing the request and any related follow-up questions, and will only be used within the context of the request.

The legal basis for processing your request is Art. 6(1)(b) GDPR. We will delete your email address after processing your request.

4. Newsletter

If you subscribe to our newsletter, we will immediately send an email to the provided email address, containing a hyperlink. By clicking on this link, you confirm your newsletter subscription (Double-Opt-In procedure). If this confirmation is not received within 360 days, we will delete the email address from our temporary list, and the subscription will not be completed.

By confirming the newsletter subscription, you consent to the storage of your email address, including the date of registration, IP address, and the name of the desired newsletter list. We will use your email address and the concurrently collected personal data only for the administration and delivery of the newsletter as specified during registration.

Our newsletters do not contain obvious or hidden counters, third-party advertising, or links to external pages unrelated to the content of our newsletter.

The legal basis for sending a newsletter to you is Art. 6(1)(a) GDPR. Each newsletter contains instructions on how to unsubscribe from the newsletter.

IV. Data Security

During your visit to the website, we use the procedures provided by <u>wix.com</u> in conjunction with the highest level of encryption supported by your browser. You can recognize whether a particular page of our website is transmitted in encrypted form by the closed display of the key or lock symbol in the address bar of your browser.

Furthermore, we employ additional suitable technical and organizational security measures to protect your data against accidental or intentional manipulation, partial or complete loss, destruction, or unauthorized access by third parties. Our security measures are continuously improved in line with technological developments.
